Dear Madam,

This is to bring to your kind notice a situation that I have been informed by some college teachers.

While the U.G. CBCS syllabus in Political Science of NBU contained two SEC Programme Courses, viz, SEC 301 (Public Opinion and Survey Research) for 3rd Sem and SEC 402 (Democratic and Legal Awareness) for 4th Sem, some colleges advised students who had opted for Political Science as DSE 2 to study the concerned courses in the 5th and 6th Semesters.

There was no such mention in the Syllabus. The Colleges allowed only students to study those courses who opted for Political Science as DSE 1.

This needs incorporation of these courses in the 5th and 6th semesters as well to enable the students who were not able to study those courses to complete the credit requirement.

It is proposed therefore that those programme courses may be incorporated (Keeping them as prescribed originally) as under :

5th Sem: SEC-501 Public Opinion and Survey Research

6th Sem: SEC 602-democratic and Legal Awareness

Further, since the truncated syllabi for 2020 needs suitable modification the relevant file is being attached for necessary action and information to all concerned.
